

**Title:** Head Start and Early Head Start– State Supplemental Grant

**Term:** October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007

**Purpose:** To enhance the school readiness of EHS / HS children by providing expanded and improved EHS/HS services to eligible children, birth to five through:

- 1) Expansion of hours and or days of services to address the full-day, year-round needs of parents who are working, attending an educational program, or attending job training.
- 2) Quality improvement measures such as accreditation.
- 3) Professional development that addresses staff and program needs such as, training in language and literacy instruction, including children with special needs in the classroom, and adaptations for English Language Learners.
- 4) Career development, based on pre-determined educational needs, that supports the education of staff through a progression of college courses, leading to two and four year college degrees in early childhood or a related field.

**Focus:** The focus area is the expansion and improvement of EHS/HS services in Maryland. Grantees are eligible to receive continuation funds by meeting the following programmatic criteria:

- Expansion services
- Quality improvement services
- Professional development
- Career Development
- Monitoring and evaluation plan for measuring results
- Curricular and instructional alignment with the Head Start Child Outcomes Framework and/or the Maryland Model for School Readiness (MMSR) ([www.mdk12/instruction/ensure/readiness/mmsr.html](http://www.mdk12/instruction/ensure/readiness/mmsr.html))
- Effective and goal-oriented collaboration with non-Head Start partners.
